

"My people will be surprised" said he to bear my talk, none of them have ever heard such words from my mouth as I am going to speak now. I do not know what you will think of me, You see the springs of my heart are broken, you may think me a woman. You all know I have been a great raider, not only myself, in my young life, but I encouraged my young men in raiding after all the other Comanche Chiefs had given it up. After the time Thomassy came to my camp, I feel very bad, I knew not what made me feel so miserable. I never felt so before, I think it all bad to raid. I look my hands all red [with blood] I no wash it off; it still stay. My whole life bad I think, I stop my young men from raiding in Texas. I tell them 'raid no more' Then I feel better for some time. By & by I feel bad again, I say 'What the Matter now - my young men no raid now.' I look my hands all dark, [blood had become dry & the old blood shed by himself dried & hard] My heart dark like my hands. I no raid - no fresh blood on hands - but all the old dark blood there yet - It no come off, I feel miserable. Something tell me 'Ask Great Spirit. He take off all the old blood stain'. I ask him, 'Make all my bad life as tho' it had not been'. I know tho' I will no live again, but some how the black stain come off & I feel better again for long time. Then after some time I think about my boy. I want him to travel good road - no travel in road I had traveled. I could not lead him in road I did not know myself. I asked Great Spirit 'Show me good road for my boy'. Something tell me 'Send him to Agency School, & he learn good way'. I send him. (You know he there. I now feel easy about him. I leave him there with you, after I tell him 'Mind all you tell him'. Now to-day you come here, I know you come because you love me & my people, & want us to travel in good way, & I feel that I want to take you in my arms." Tears all this time were coursing down his furrowed cheeks. The Agent rising up replied "White Wolf I feel the same way" & suit

ing the action to the word they a hearty embrace. He did the Agent so did we. There was a Christian experience on the part of one who had no outward knowledge of Christ - an exercise of faith by one who knew not what faith is.

Some time after this, very early one 1<sup>st</sup> day morning White Wolf rode up to the Agency, requesting to see the Agent. The Agent directed his admittance into his apartment. He said "I want you to tell me whether I am a wise man or fool, I awake up this morning, something tell me this Agents Medicine day, you go make medicine with Agent. I know not what it was. Now you know whether yours Medicine day or not, I do not know. If Medicine day I stay make medicine with you, if not I go home" Clapping him on the shoulder the Agent replied "White Wolf you are a wise man. This is Medicine Day" Accordingly he staid & went with us to the first day school & meeting securing breakfast & dinner in the bargain.

In the early part of the summer of 1877 Dr. C. G. Given, who had taken a deep interest in the religious instruction of the Indians, was about to leave for his home in Iowa, his place having been supplied by another Physician after his resignation. The day before he was to leave three or four chiefs who had manifested much interest in the subjects of his instruction, came in to take leave of him. He gave them suitable advice, informing them that he had been a long time with them, but was now going to leave them, that he might go & take care of his father & mother who were getting very old; - One of them, - a Comanche Chief said "We are sorry you go away from us where we can no see you any more. You have given us good medicine when we sick, you have given us good talk. Much of your talk has settled down to our hearts, & we shall often think of you. We know that you pray to Great Spirit every morning, noon & night. We ~~too~~ have learned to pray to Great Spirit. We pray to him every morning, noon & night, & now though you go so far away that we cannot see your face, our spirits will go up, three times every day, before
