BILL #13 APPROVED BY WILLIAM BRYANT

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled,

That no citizen or citizens of this Nation shall be allowed to settle within four hundred and fifty yards on a direct line from the exterior boundary of a former settler's improvement without his or her consent.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That any citizen or citizens violating the said act shall be subject to removal to the distance from the former settler as specified in the above section, by the sheriff of the proper county, and shall pay the cost incurred by the sheriff in such removal, and moreover shall pay damages to the former settler to be determined by three discreet persons,
