A. A. S. Dept of the
Supt Wallace's Coy

1. Lieut W. M. Wallace with twenty-five (25) militia men of H. Co. 5. Cavalry will proceed on a scout tomorrow.

First day, he will proceed by the old Camp Supply road to the crossing of Mulberry creek. Second day, thence by the same road to Fish Creek. Third day, thence to Blue creek. Fourth day, down this creek about fourteen (14) miles. Fifth day, down this creek to head of Salt plain of Cimarron. Sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth, and eleventh, days up the Cimarron river to near Sand creek. Twelfth, thirteenth, fourteenth, and fifteenth, days across to Grand creek, and to this post.

Lieut Wallace will be governed in his intercourse with Indians by written orders previously given him.

The Quar. Mstr. Dept will furnish horses (5), six (6) mule teams and one (1) ambulance. Rations and forage will be furnished for fifteen (15) days and an abundant supply of ammunition. Supt Harper B. Co. Batt of Engineers, and Interpreter Ramos will report to Lieut Wallace to accompany him on the scout.
