19 men in hayfield - a.m. - 9:30 - Indians yell + shoot -  
whites ran for corral + O.K. - soldiers had breechloaders  
+ 50 cartridges apiece - 6 civilians had repeating rifles -  
Had to keep out of sight -

At the start

Lt. Stenberg + 1 soldier stood up to show off their carriage +  
were both k. Others lay down + kept hidden - behind

logs - everything above that was hit by Indians -  
the Capt + Colvin was good shot, 16 shot repeater + 1000  
cartridges - fired 300 times + k. many Indians (?)

~~One~~ He shot 1st Ind. to cross creek -

His brother shot another one coming with a fire brand?
