It is mutually agreed between Alvaren Allen of St. Paul, Minnesota and  
Chief Sitting Bull \* \* \* \*

Sitting Bull agrees that he and eight other Indians and squaws  
\* \* \* \* will visit fifteen cities in the United States under the  
full control and direction of said Allen ; \* \* \* \* \* THE SAID  
Allen agrees to pay to said Sitting Bull as compensation, the sum  
of one Hundred dollars per month \* \* \* \* and to the balance of the  
party (eight in number) ten dollars per month each and all their  
traveling expenses and other expenses \* \* \* \* \*

Signed in duplicate at St Paul, Minn., this  
Fourth day of September 1884.
