They say that after Bear Rib's death the ones who wanted to kill him ran into the fort and shut the gate and kept the friends of BearsRib's out. Afterwards the trader talked them into paying Bear's Rib's friends for his death. I would like to know what Sitting Bull did and said that day when Bear's Ribwas killed.
