Dear Campbell:

Those notes on Sitting Bull are much too valuable to have in the office here. If I had a safe or vault big enough to hold them, it would be another matter. But, as it is, I can't take them.

We have however called the National City Bank and you can store the things there, in the silver vaults, at the following rate: \$1.50 per month for the first \$1,000. of value and 50¢ per month for each additional thousand. I suggest that you may send the things there; they will be responsible for them after they are received; up to that time the risk is on you or on the Express Company.
