with him by the bitterness shown that night. It seemed to me that if it were generally known that he had killed Custer some hot head might attack or kill the old man. I therefore respected his wishes. But now that he is dead, these facts might add something interesting to the book. If anyone requires corroboration of this exploit, he might reflect that White Bull was the Indian chosen to lead the Indian column at the Fiftieth Anniversary of the fight at the battlefield.

I should like to have your reaction to this suggestion.
