I have your note returning Sitting Bull manuscript, and find your question on the margin "How many soldiers were in the command that morning?" I cannot say for sure how many troopers there were. My recollection is that our troops at that time carried 60 <sup>enlisted</sup> men on paper, but were seldom full. Of course, there were many men left behind on various duties in the post; so I think there could not have been more than 80 or 90 men present in the two troops.
