Bear Mrs. Holtzman:

Thanks very much for your letter. I have no complete data on the Sitting Bull family. I believe his last surviving son, the deaf mute, is now dead. You might learn something by writing to Judge Frank Zahm at Fort Yates, North Dakota. He is the son of a Sioux woman and a veteran of the Seventh Cavalry. He is well educated and well informed, and at one time was employed to work on the rolls of the Standing Rock Agency, where Sitting Bull lived and died.

It may be that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs in Washington has information on this point.

There are several philanthropic societies which attempt to aid the Indians. However, I am not associated with any of these at the present time.
