After the army returned to the Heart River they were in the Bad Lands between the Little Missouri River and Sentinel known as the Battle of the Bad Lands. It was a hard land, for the drought took most of the feed, and what grasshoppers ate. Hundreds of horses and mules died in the flat-topped butte country.
