This evening, the Train having the Indian presents arrived and formed a corral, much to the joy and delight of every one. It was amusing to see how this item of news spread through the indian villages and how soon a crowd ofmen, squaws and children, could collect. It was late in the evening when the train came up, but notwithstanding, they were surrounded until a very late hour in the night. We have now a prospect of a speedy conclusion of the neogetiations, and early departure from this place.
