Aged One Bull is Near Death

One Bull, Sioux chief and a nephew of the famous Sitting Bull, is in a critical condition at his home in Little Eagle, S. D., as a result of a fall he received while chasing a horse several days ago.

He struck a stone with his head as he fell. The blow, coupled with his advanced age, makes his condition critical, Col. A. B. Welch said today. The old Indian is more than 80.

Welch, accompanied by F. W. McKendry, visited the old Indian Friday at his home after a card advised him of the chieftan's fall. A. McLaughlin (S.D.) doctor accompanied them to Little Eagle.

At Cannon Ball, on the return trip, Welch and McKendry attended a Sioux ceremony ending the mourning of Mr. and Mrs. Walking Thunder Hawk and Mr. and Mrs. Yellow Hawk.
