Dear Campbell:

That reference to Sitting Bull's taking part in a buffalo hunt is from William T. Hornaday's report on the extermination of the bison, in Report of the United States National Museum, 1887. I can't give you the page reference now; Major Lillie wrote me about two weeks ago asking me to send that Report to him. (It's in the section called "Extermination of the Northern Herd.") There's no more data there, however, than the simple statement I've used.

There may be something in one or all of these titles:

W. Fletcher Johnson -- The Life of Sitting Bull and the History of the Indian War, 1890 - 1891. (Phila. 1891)

✓ John G. Bourke -- On the Border with Crook. (New York 1891)

W Capt. Charles King -- Campaigns with Crook and Stories of Army Life. (N. Y. 1905)

These last two most likely describe only the Apache campaigns; I don't know them.

If I turn up anything in my own grubbing, of course I'll pass it along.
