Geographical limits.--States of Iowa and Nebraska; Territories of Utah and Wyoming (excepting of the latter the camp on Snake River and supply depot as Rawlins Station), and so much of the Territory of Idaho as lies east of a line formed by the embracing the post of Fort Hall, Idaho.

Troops.--3d and 5th Cavalry; 4th, 6th, and 9th Infantry.
