Sitting Bull rode a grey horse in the Buffalo Bill
wild west show, season 1885.

X When the show closed the season, 1885, at St Louis Mo,
Col Cody presented the horse to Sitting Bull, and paid
the transportation charges on the horse back to Sitting
Bulls reservation in So Dakota.

No doubt this is the horse Sitting Bull wished to be
saddled just before he was killed.

X The horse was a fairly light grey, about 16-1 in
height.

Old Bull was very fond of this horse which prompted
Buffalo Bill to give it to him.
