I received your kind letter and I am so glad you will help me. The work has been a very tedious job, to find when and where the chiefs lived and died, the ones who fought and surrendered. My theory of the Eastern Sioux and other tribes that were not Axtles who emigrated along the Atlantic coast, were people who came north from central Mexico perhaps before the Axtles reached down there. I gather this idea from legends told by the Sioux and other tribes, and also their westward migration, by words of the Sioux, they had traded with the Dutch traders, my manuscript is more or less disconnected because I wrote it as I got it. I am waiting for some pictures, I set for and I am having some copied so it may be two weeks before I can send it. I will write to you again.
