Somewhat later the boy's aunt, whose husband was then away on the warpath, asked her nephew to take her husband's gun and kill some meat for her. Bull-Standing-with-Cow was pleased with this commission; he had never hunted with a gun before. The set out along Powder River where spoons horns (big horn sheep) were plentiful. He lay in wait for them at the watering place and dropped one when they came down to drink. Soon after he killed a coyote and a prairie dog, and before the day was over brought down his first white-bellied deer (a prong horned antelope). With this varied bag, he went back to camp and returned the weapon to his aunt. It was a muzzle-loading single-shot gun.
