Bull Ghost was that man who was called One-Eyed Reilly. Brown Otter (not Yellow Otter) was one of SB's warriors. About the same age as SB and One Eyed Reilly.

Male Bear - He lives about 8 or 10 miles southeast of Bullhead. Probably could tell something of SB's last days.

Iron White Man - Died about 8 or 9 years ago. Something like Male Bear. They were Silent Eaters. These two men are rather troublesome.
