of making a study of the Indians thereon, except the Kiowa reservation in Oklahoma which has been thrown open to settlement, permission should be obtained from this Office.

The conditions upon which such permission would be granted, are that the applicant should state his purpose specifically, show his responsibility, and agree to comply with the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of the Interior for the government of the Indians.

Upon receipt of such applications, letters of introduction to the Superintendents will be furnished.
