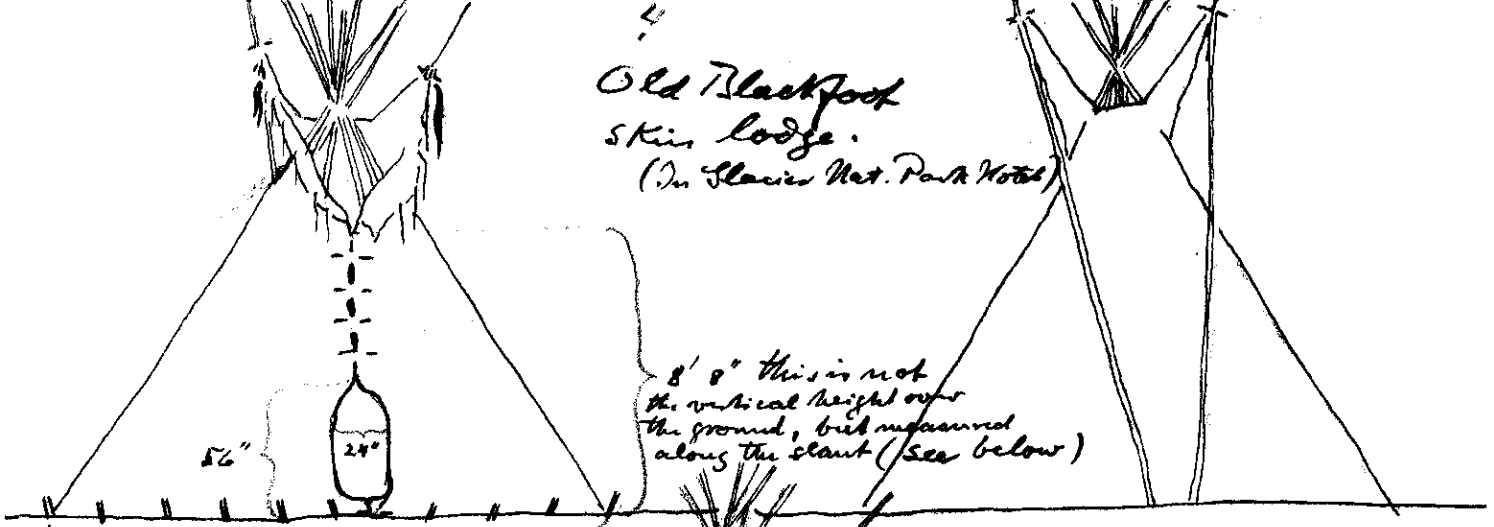

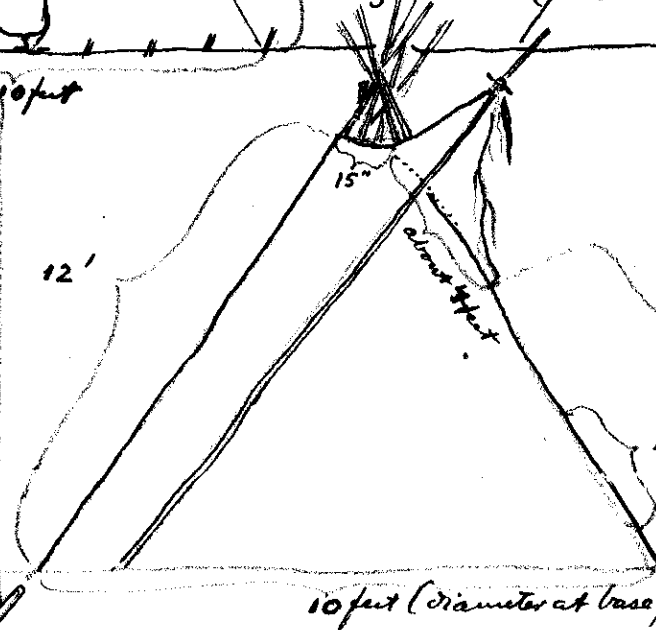
8' 8" this is not the vertical height over the ground, but measured along the slant (See below)

13 poles in all (incl. the smoke flap poles)

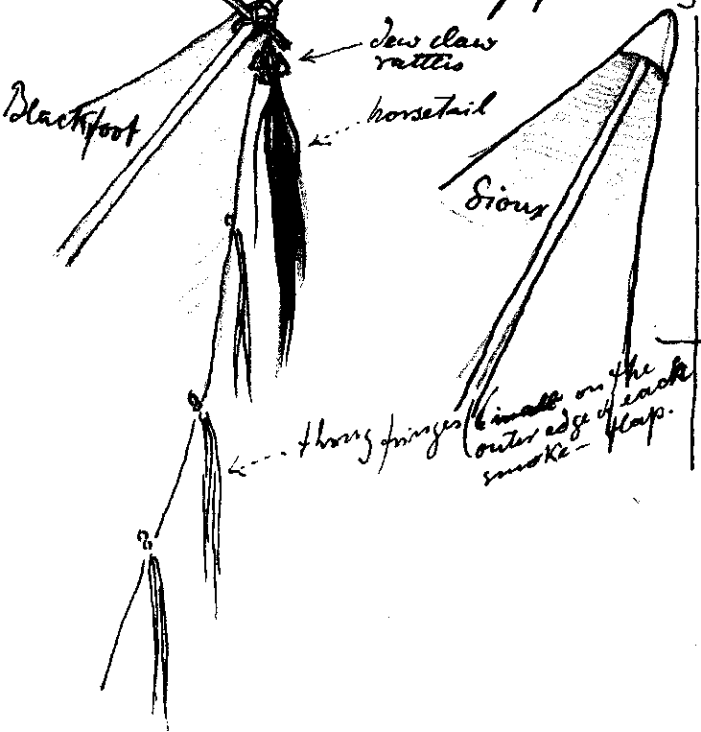
