

The purpose of these pen-drawings is only to indicate in a general way some scene contained in each chapter.

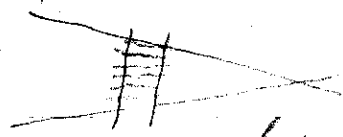
