Dear Professor :-

Enclosed you will find the "Scheme for Arrangement of etc." for which you asked in your last letter.

I have started - after disposing of some other unavoidable work - to paint the inset picture of the book cover for H. H. S. It is a small oil painting about  $11 \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ ". The same picture will be used for the book cover and the "jacket" (i.e. the outer paper cover). The picture will be reduced to the proper size in the reproductions but the rest of the design for the book cover must be made exactly in the size of the book, so that I can hardly start on that work until a publisher has accepted the MS. and stated what size the book is to have. But to be prepared, I would like to have all the details ready. The design you saw with the illustrations was little more than a suggestion. I would like to know the exact wording of what is to appear on the book cover.

So far as I can see in books I happen to have, it is customary to put on the outer cover the title of the book and the name of the author only, and, it seems, the name of the author complete.
