Sir:-

I am in receipt of yours of the 29th ultimo re information from Indians of this Agency who had contact with Sitting Bull during his stay in Canada. In reply I beg to say that I never hear his name mentioned by the Indians of this Agency.

Very few of the Old Timers are living who might have met Sitting Bull, unless it be some of the Sioux of White Caps Band who live on Moose Woods Reserve, twenty two miles South West of the City of Saskatoon.

If you would write Chas. R. Eagle a member of this band, whose Post Office address is Dundurn. Sask. he would make enquiries and let you know and also make arrangements for you meeting them at a place and time convenient to yourself.

I regret to say that I did not receive your letter dated April 7th 1930.
