a Mounted Police officer has ceased to exist except for a menument elected in memory of the Pest, and I doubt if you will find many Indians of the past except the two of whom I write, for the Sioux who remained in Canada for the most part stayed at Wood Mountain. In Po Plar, Montana, their might be some survivors. If it is of any use to you my & services are wholly at your disposal if only for the reason that we have kindred takes
