Yours of Dec 23^d is here and much appreciated. I am re-publishing your "Archaic Indian" and already have expressed my commendations to the publisher. Are the Navajo as a Pith Indian - this is potentially rather than present and specific rather than a general condition. Many of them are very poor. There is no tribal fund as with the Apache & no annuities are paid them. Much wealth as is there is in the way of sheep & cattle mostly - There are some old creeks in the reservation but there have been no per capita distributions of funds -
