My Dear Stanley

Yours of Dec 23<sup>d</sup> is here and much appreciated. I am re-publishing your "Archaean Indian" and already have expressed my commendations to the publisher. Are the Navajo as a Rich Indian - this is potentially rather than present and specific rather than a general condition. Many of them are very poor. There is no tribal fund as with the Osage & no annuities are paid them. Rich mostly as is there is in the way of sheep & cattle mostly - There are some oil wells on the reservation but there have been no per capita distributions of funds -
