**A BILL**

Authorizing the erection of a monument to Sacajawea.

1     *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2     *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3     That the Secretary of the Interior is authorized and directed  
4     to erect a suitable monument to the memory of Sacajawea,  
5     the Indian woman who accompanied Lewis and Clark and  
6     rendered valuable service to them as a guide and interpreter  
7     on their expedition to the Northwest, at or near the place  
8     of her burial on the Wind River Indian Reservation in  
9     Wyoming. The design of such monument shall have the  
10    approval of the National Commission of Fine Arts.

11    SEC. 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
