## A BILL

Authorizing the erection of a monument to Sacajawea.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the Secretary of the Interior is authorized and directed
- 4 to erect a suitable monument to the memory of Sacajawea,
- 5 the Indian woman who accompanied Lewis and Clark and
- 6 rendered valuable service to them as a guide and interpreter
- 7 on their expedition to the Northwest, at or near the place
- 8 of her burial on the Wind River Indian Reservation in
- 9 Wyoming. The design of such monument shall have the
- 10 approval of the National Commission of Fine Arts.
- 11 SEC. 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
