Also, I wonder if you can clear up a difficulty in some research I am doing. It appears that the Hudson's Bay Company fur brigade. under Ogden or Work or both, in the 1830s spent one season near Salt Lake. In the account given by Mrs. Frances Fuller Vactor in THE RIVER OF THE WEST, she savs that the British had with them some Rockaway Indians, apparently from Canada. Was there sny such tribe or band that you know of? I have thought it possible they might be connected with the Stoney tribe, or Stoneboilers or Assimiboines, but perhaps this is too far-fetched.
