McLaughlin.

In a letter dated Feb 18-1891, to Co , of Ind fffairs, Mclaughlin aays; Report is absurd that there are 1500 stands of anms secreted by Indians near Fort Stevenaon. "After the Custer expodition in 1876 Sittine Bull and his followers fled to Canada and every deseription of fire arm which was then in their possession was atsposed of in Canada to obtain necessary food for their subsistence before the surrender in 1880 or 1881, so that it was impossible with the means they have had aince to accumalate the muber of arms reported to have been concealed."
