

Swarlow - Indian Tribes of North America

Kaskaias - translated "bad hearts"

Kiowa Apache

Bad-hearts - by Long (1823) (See Kaskaias)

Cancey or Kantsi - "liars", applied by the Gaddo to all Apache of the Plains, but oftenest to the Lipan
Essequēta - name given by the Kiowa and Comanche to the Mescalero Apache, sometimes, but improperly, applied to this tribe.

Gataka - Pawnee name

Ginas - Wichita name

Gutak - Omaha and Ponca name

Kapatop - Kiowa name, meaning "Knife whetters."

Kisinahis - Kichai name

Mutsianataniu - Cheyenne name, meaning "whetstone people."

Nadiishadena - own name meaning "our people."

Pacer band of Apache, H.R. Doc.

Prairie Apaches, - common name

Sadalsomtekiago - Kiowa name meaning "weasel people."

Tagugala - Jemez name for Apache tribes including Kiowa Apache.

Tagui, - an old Kiowa name

Tagukerish - Pecos name for all Apache

Tashin - Comanche name for all Apache.

Thakahinen - Arapaho name meaning "saw-fiddle man."

Yabipais Natage - Garces Diary (1776)
