A NUMBER OF EMINENT OFFICIALS OF THIS STATE ARE UNABLE TO BE WITH US BECAUSE OF OTHER BINDING COMMITMENTS. GOVERNOR GARY HAS ASKED ME TO EXPRESS HIS PROFOUND REGRET AT BEING UNABLE TO ATTEND. SENATOR KERR AND SENATOR MONRONEY AND THE ABLE REPRESENTATIVES FROM OKLAHOMA IN CONGRESS WERE UNABLE TO COME BECAUSE OF THE CURRENT HEAVY LEGISLATIVE SCHEDULE IN WASHINGTON. THEY ALSO HAVE ASKED ME TO EXPRESS THEIR REGRETS TO YOU. SIMILARLY, THERE ARE MANY CLOSE FRIENDS OF THE RENOWNED CHIEF AND OF THE PARKER FAMILY THAT COULD NOT BE HERE TODAY. AMONG THEM IS MR.
