the school and agency buildings, and so on. If they clash at any point with the regular federal Forest Service, or Reclamation Service, or Supervising Architect's Service, enough time and energy is spent in the contest to have accomplished some real results if directed into profitable channels. I made earnest efforts while in office to bring about a coördination between the Indian Service and some of the better equipped Services outside which would reduce the economic waste to a minimum; but departmental

jealousies and diverse constructions of law made short work of them later. About the only remnant of this coöperative machinery still in working order is, I believe, the arrangement with the Department of Agriculture under which its Plant Industry experts have interested our Southwestern Indians in the culture of Egyptian cotton, Bermuda onions, and certain nutritious fruits. The success of this experiment shows what might be done if the coöperative idea were carried out everywhere.
