SEC. 2. In accordance with the foregoing purposes, 1 the Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized to issue $\mathbf{2}$ to the Indians residing upon any Indian reservation or 3 reservations or subdivision thereof a charter granting to the 4 said community group any or all of such powers of govern-5 ment and such privileges of corporate organization and eco-6 7 nomic activity, hereinafter enumerated, as may seem fitting in the light of the experience, capacities, and desires of the 8 Indians concerned; but no such charter shall take effect 9 10 until ratified by a three-fifths vote at a popular election open to all adult Indians resident within the territory cov-11 12 ered by the charter. Upon receipt of a petition for the issuance of a charter 13 signed by one fourth of the adult Indians residing on any 14 existing reservation, it shall be the duty of the Secretary 15 of the Interior to make the necessary investigations and 16 17 issue a proper charter, subject to ratification, or shall pro-18 claim the conditions upon which such charter will be issued; 19 and such petition, with a record of the findings and of the action of the Secretary, shall be transmitted by the Secretary 20 21 of the Interior to Congress: Provided, That whenever the 22 Secretary of the Interior shall acquire land not comprised 23 within any existing reservation for the purpose of establish-24 ing a new Indian community, pursuant to the authority 25 granted by title III of this Act, he shall issue a charter to
