- 1 izations comprised within the community, or to a propor-
- 2 tionate share thereof, except as such succession may be
- 3 limited by the charter, subject to existing provisions of
- 4 law with respect to the maintenance of suits against the
- 5 United States, and subject further to such provision for
- 6 the apportionment of such assets among nonmembers of
- 7 the community having vested rights therein, as may be
- 8 prescribed by the charter.
- 9 Sec. 5. When any Indian community shall have been
- 10 chartered, it shall be the duty of the Commissioner of Indian
- 11 Affairs to cause regular reports concerning their respective
- 12 functions to be made to the constituted authorities of the
- 13 community, to advise and consult with such authorities on
- 14 problems of local administration and Federal policy, and
- 15 to allow such authorities free access to the records and
- 16 files of the local agency.
- 17 Any Indian community shall have the power to com-
- 18 pel the transfer from the community of any persons em-
- 19 ployed in the administration of Indian affairs within the
- 20 territorial limits of the community other than persons ap-
- 21 pointed by the community: Provided, however, That the
- 22 Commissioner of Indian Affairs may prescribe such condi-
- 23 tions for the exercise of this power as will assure to employ-
- 24 ees of the Indian Service a reasonable security of tenure, an
