2 complaints and charges.

3 SEC. 6. The Secretary shall prepare annual estimates
4 of expenditures for the administration of Indian affairs, in-
5 cluding expenditures for functions and services adminis-
6 tered by an Indian community, pursuant to the authority
7 conferred by section 8 of this title. It shall be the duty
8 of the Secretary to transmit to the authorized representative
9 of an Indian community any estimates and justifications
10 thereof for expenditures to be made in whole or in part
11 within the territorial limits of the community. Any recom-
12 mendation of the authorized representatives of the com-
13 munity, including the approval or rejection of any item in
14 whole or in part, or the recommendation of any other ex-
15 penditure, shall be transmitted by the Secretary to the
16 Bureau of the Budget and to the Congress concurrently with
17 the submission of the estimates of the Secretary.

18 The Secretary shall also transmit to the authorized
19 representatives of an Indian community a copy of any bill,
20 or amendment of a bill, for the benefit of Indians, authoriz-
21 ing, in whole or in part, the appropriation or expenditure,
22 within the territorial limits of such community, of any funds
23 from the Federal Treasury for which the Secretary of the
24 Interior has submitted no estimates, and the Secretary shall
25 transmit their written recommendations to the Congress.
