- 1 and subdivisions which may be separably transferred. The
- 2 Commissioner is further authorized and directed to proceed,
- 3 immediately after the passage of this Act, to make a study
- 4 and investigation of the conditions upon which separable
- 5 functions and services may be transferred to the Indian com-
- 6 munities and thereupon to promulgate, direct, and express
- 7 rules and regulations to govern such transfer.
- The said rules and regulations shall set forth all condi-
- 9 ditions reasonably necessary to assure the satisfactory and
- 10 continued administration of the function or service trans-
- 11 ferred. The said rules and regulations shall include stand-
- 12 ards of fitness for Indians with respect to health, age,
- 13 character, knowledge, and ability, for any position main-
- 14 tained, now or hereafter, before or after transfer to an
- 15 Indian community, for the administration of functions or
- 16 services within the territorial limits of any community, and
- 17 a classification of all positions for which the requisite
- 18 knowledge and training may be acquired by Indians through
- 19 experience or apprenticeship in the position. The said rules
- 20 and regulations shall also set forth for each separable func-
- 21 tion or service, as a condition of its transfer, the positions
- 22 for which Indians shall qualify and the required number
- 23 of qualified Indians for each such position, provisions assur-
- 24 ing a reasonable security of tenure, and any other conditions
