

1 in and to any land included in any Indian public domain
2 allotment, homestead, or application therefor, which has here-
3 tofore or may hereafter be made, where such land lies within
4 the exterior boundaries of any Indian reservation or area
5 heretofore or hereafter set apart and reserved for the use and
6 benefit of any Indian tribe or band; and the Secretary of
7 the Interior is hereby authorized and empowered to cancel
8 any patent which may have been issued conveying such
9 land, or any interest therein, to any Indian allottee or Indian
10 homestead entryman.

11 Title to any land acquired pursuant to the provisions
12 of this section shall be taken in the name of the United
13 States in trust for the Indian tribe or community for whom
14 the land is acquired, but title may be transferred by the
15 Secretary to such community under the conditions set forth
16 in this Act.

17 SEC. 8. Any Indian tribe or chartered Indian com-
18 munity is authorized to purchase or otherwise acquire any
19 interest of any member or nonmember in land within its
20 territorial limits, and may expend any tribal or community
21 funds, whether or not held in the Treasury of the United
22 States, for this purpose, whenever, in the opinion of the
23 Secretary of the Interior the acquisition is necessary for
24 the proper consolidation of Indian lands.
