FROM THERE I HOPE TO RUN UP TO THE SITE OF OLD FT. UNION AT THE YELLOWSTONE AND MISSOURI JUNCTION. THENCE BROK TO FT. YATES AND VICINITY.

IFTHERE IS ANYTHING ESPECIAL AT THE BUTTES YOUDESIRE, WRITE ME AT ONCE AND I WILL ADD IT TO WHAT EVER I MAY HAVE.
