Mar 30 Term of surrender read in Washington

The President ~~decided~~ <sup>refused</sup> that their imprisonment  
in the East for 2 yrs + their return to the  
reservation could not be approved

Instructions were sent - But before  
Cross rec'd them, Gerónimo + Natchez  
with 50 men + 13 women left Lt. Mans'

Camp on the 29<sup>th</sup> March + escaped to N.M.

The rest of his band were sent to Fort  
Marion, Fla. as P.W. Children sent  
to Ind Sch at Carlisle.

Lt Mans of J's trail until satisfied  
that further pursuit at that time was  
useless. Usual sad results, Pt of loads  
to Sierra Madre in Mex marked by  
atrocities
