Five companies of the 23d Regiment-D.C. K, A and G.-Col R. I. Dodge commanding, arrived in this city, by special train, Wednesday morning. They are encamped on the opposite side of the river, and will to take up their line of march for the new camp, sixty miles southeast of Fort Supply. The boys have a theatrical company and will wear the tedium of a frontier life with amusements.

Company I, of the same regiment, is mounted, and will leave Leavenworth today for the same post, going by way of Wichita. This company will take the women and children of the seven Chayenne captives, now in our jail, to the reservation near fort Reno.
