

after which he means to resign--He is engaged in procuring supplies for the Indians and requests me to state that he shall draw for about \$4000.

The land office at this place is doing more business at this time than it ever has done before. In one day of this week they received \$3000. The sales are principally in the stripe above mentioned westwardly of the boundary established at Greenville--

This tract of 50 miles by 12 is nearly all sold and has already put into the Treasury at least \$200,000--It furnishes an argument in favor of a further extinguishment of title in that direction at no very distant day-but against its being done immediately because the United States are now selling lands of an inferior quality up to the very boundary--The moment that a further extinguishment of title is effected these sales will cease and the people will push over the line and squat upon the choice tracts in anticipation of the sales--
