A Mr. Perry reported to me to day, as being sent here with instructions from General Sheridan concerning Indian Affairs;

A quantity of arms and ammunition has been issued to the Arrapahoes and Cheyennes, as promised by the Indian Commissioner and the agent has
promised to issue more to the Arrapahoes, when the annuity goods are issued.
