Mrs. Lumpkin was so appreciative that during the Red Cross roll call, though her funds were low, she walked all the way from West Tulsa to take out a membership. She now lives on a small farm east of the city. Her son, John William Lumpkin, was killed in France in October 1918, while in service with company K, 140th infantry.
