T. J. KEENER SUCCEMBS
AT RESIDENCE IN VIAN

Well known Oklahoma Merchant is Buried Tuesday With Funeral Services at Home

Stricken suddenly with illness Monday evening shortly after he had eaten a hearty dinner, T. J. Keener, Vian, Okla., merchant, and well known in this city, died at 7 o'clock Monday night at his home in Vian. He was 65 years old, and while he was a sufferer from high blood pressure, was apparently in his usual health until 15 minutes before his death.

Mr. Keener was a brother-in-law of G. E. Heron and an uncle by marriage of Jack Heron and G. E. Heron Jr., of the Boston store, all of whom went to Vian for the funeral Tuesday afternoon. Services were conducted from the family home with burial in the Vian cemetery.

Besides his wife, Mrs. Norcia Leftwich Keener and an only daughter, Norcia Lula Keener, Mr. Keener leaves a sister who resides in McAlester, and a sister-in-law, Mrs. Charles B. Underdonk of New York City, formerly Miss Kate Leftwich.

Mrs. Underdonk will arrive in Vian Thursday to be with her sister. She received a telegram notifying her of her brother-in-law's death, but could not arrive in time for the funeral.
