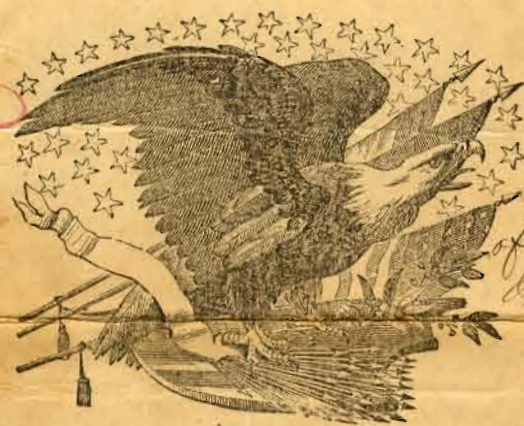

Know ye, That Co - ge - bul - ee a
Private of Captain Alex. C. Spelman's
Company, (B.) 3rd Regiment of Indian Home Guards
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the 24th day of July
one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two to serve three years or
during the war, is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States
this Thirty-first day of May, 1865, at Fort
Gibson C. N. by reason of A. C. No. 110 extract 3rd Dept of A. K. under authority of War Dept. dated Feb 12, 65
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Co - ge - bul - ee was born in Saline
in the State of Cherokee Nation, is Twenty years of age,
Five feet eight inches high, Dark complexion, Black eyes
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer
Given at Fort Gibson C. N. this Thirty-first day of
May 1865.
