Company, (C.) 2<sup>d</sup> Regiment of Indian Infantry, Lenore Guards  
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August  
one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two to serve Three years or  
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,  
this thirty-first day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson  
Cherokee Nation by reason of unfit for service 110 Dept of Arkansas of 1865  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said John Spruce was born in  
in the State of Cherokee Nation, is 24 years of age.  
Five feet 7 inches high, Copper complexion, Black eyes,  
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer
