- 7. *Daily Capital*, January 23, 1897: "An Act signed by R.M. Harris" creating a commission to visit Washington, DC to protest against the ratification by Congress of the agreement made and entered into between the Dawes Commission, on the part of the United States, and the Choctaws.
- 8. *Indian Citizen*, January 28, 1897: "An Act signed by R.M. Harris". The same act as described above.
- 9. Special Message of R.M. Harris to the Chickasaw Legislature. re: the Dawes-Choctaw Treaty, February 25, 1897.
- 10. *Indian Citizen*, March 4, 1897: "Report of Chickasaw Commission signed by R.M. Harris" on the protest against the ratification of the Dawes-Choctaw Treaty.
