In 1966 the G.D. Searle Pharmaceutical Company of Illinois developed a pigeon contraceptive called Ornitrol as part of a Battle Creek, Michigan study. That contraceptive was never used in Battle Creek's pigeon "control".

Instead, Tanglefoot (owner of Tanglefoot Company was then Mayor of Battle Creek, Preston Kool's relative) was used from 1975 to 1983---and Avitrol (a modified version of Ornitrol) has been used since 1983. Both methods are scare tactics which was used to rid the downtown of unwanted pigeons. 2

Ornitrol was not used because more federal funds could be tricked out of the Federal Government to rectify the health hazard the pigeons, premeditatedly proven, was set-up to cause: "The nest, states Professor of Biology, Joel Carl Welthy in his book, THE LIFE OF BIRDS of the filthy pigeons become such a culture medium for vermin that in one nest 6,573 individual insects and other invertebrates of 58 species were found in one liter of nest-bottom material". 3--i.e, Infant and Maternal mortality and Michigan's latest NAZI scheme---mass injection of pigeon diseases targeted at the cream of the crop of inner city young males. 4
